Criteria for Freshman Admission through Direct Admission:

Students who graduate from secondary school prior to enrollment at NEIU will be eligible for **direct admission** if they have a GPA of 2.50 on a 4.00 scale.

Students below a 2.50 GPA may still be eligible for admission throughout a review process and are encouraged to apply.

NEIU does not require test scores for admission, but students can submit their ACT or SAT score to determine math and English course placement and for scholarship consideration.

Criteria for Transfer Admission through Direct Admission:

To be eligible for **Direct Admission** to the institution as a transfer student, a student must have completed 30 credit hours of post-secondary coursework at a regionally accredited institution of higher education with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale.

Students seeking to transfer with 1 to 23 college credits completed after completing high school must also submit final and official high school transcripts showing a 2.5+ high school GPA. Only those with 30 credit hours will be eligible for a Direct Admission offer(s).
