Criteria for Freshman Admission through Direct Admission:

Students who graduate from secondary school prior to enrollment at SIUE will be eligible for **direct admission** if they have a GPA of 2.60 on a 4.00 scale.

If you did not get an offer of Direct Admission to Southern Illinois University Edwardsville, you are eligible for admission if:

- You have a cumulative GPA of a 2.0 and an SAT score of 990 or an ACT score of 19; or
- If you are in the top 10% of your high school graduating class.

Students with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 - 2.59 without the specified SAT or ACT scores will be considered for enrollment via the Admission Review Committee.

Criteria for **Transfer Admission** through **Direct Admission**:

To be eligible for **Direct Admission** to the institution as a transfer student, a student must have completed 30 credit-hours of post-secondary coursework at a regionally accredited institution of higher education with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale.

Note: For applicants who are applying to programs that require a portfolio review, audition, or other limited admissions requirements (which may include a GPA above general admission criteria, an SAT or ACT), they must still meet those requirements for admissions consideration to those programs.
